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Internet Business From Home – The Basics

You have chosen a great platform if you have decided to run an internet business from home. Imagine having a shop on a street that everybody in the world could walk down every day, occasionally popping into yours and checking out your products. Imagine how much you could sell!

There are disadvantages of course. You must have a product to sell that people want, and you must persuade them to pop into your shop. You must also keep them there when they walk in the door, and not just walk out again because they don't like the look of the interior. Your shop must be well designed and look welcoming, with lots of stuff on display that they can browse through.

That's the internet. If you have a product to sell you set up a website, which is your online store. It's not difficult to start up a website but your product must have a USP, or unique selling proposition, that will persuade customers to buy from you rather than from another internet site. There will likely be plenty suppliers for the product that you are selling, unless it is truly unique, such as a brand new piece of software.

Most people, however, are selling hard goods or other people's products as an affiliate. Affiliate marketing is a great way for those new to internet marketing to start running until they have learned enough to expand into their own products. Your USP could be something as simple as a free gift with every purchase, a 5 part email course or anything else you can think of that sets you apart from the shop next door.

No matter what kind of business you start with, you will generally need a website if you are going to be successful at working with an internet business from home. If you don't know where to start you have two or three options. You can start with a good web hosting system that charges a monthly fee for the provision of all that is needed for you build your website and operate it professionally.

Such services cost in the region of up to \$30 monthly, and provide web design software that takes you by the hand and shows you how to design and build your site either from scratch or by using templates. They also provide email services, autoresponders, checkouts and a means of accepting payment by credit and debit cards. This type of system is good for beginners.

On the other hand you can purchase websites that are ready to run with products already loaded to get you off to a start. If all you want is a website, you could have one designed for you. To avoid the normal high costs associated with this you might be lucky and have a student in your neighborhood who needs to make a few bucks.

Whatever way you go about it, make it look attractive since when a visitor enters your site, it is like going through your shop door. The interior must look attractive to them with plenty offers on show to keep them there for that vital few seconds during

which statistics show they are more likely to leave than to stay. Most visitors visit websites for less than thirty seconds.

Once you have built it you must advertise it. You don't just put a website on the internet then sit back, because nobody knows it exists. You must promote it by advertising it. If you are selling cheeses, you could put advertisements in cheese magazines, or you could write articles about cheeses and submit them to article directories. Anyone interested in cheeses will search the directories and come across your articles with your website link on them.

Once your visitor finds your site you could offer inducements to get their name and email address, such as a free seven part course on making their own cheese. Once you have their email address you can keep in touch and send them special offers now and again. Never let a visitor leave your site without you getting their email address.

There are many other ways of advertising your internet home business and attracting visitors. Starting an internet business from home is not difficult, and to recap the steps:

First, decide on your product. If you have one, then great. If not, then you can look for affiliate programs, where you sell other people's products for a cut of the sales price, frequently 50%.

Second get a website, either a new one or use a program that provides a ready-made website already filled with products. You will come across these as you become more involved in internet marketing.

Finally, advertise. Promote your website and your products in any way you can think of. There is plenty of useful advice and help on the internet on how to go about promoting your website. Follow these steps and you will soon be running an internet business from home that will provide you with the freedom of working for yourself rather than for a boss.

Home Business Ideas for Beginners

You are new to internet marketing and you need some advice on how to start. You are not alone, and here are some home business ideas for beginners to the big, big, world of internet marketing.

The fact that you are new to this business does not necessarily imply that you do not have a product. In fact most people who enter into internet marketing with their eyes open either have a product to sell or an idea for one. However, let's assume that you have none and are looking for a quick entry into this fascinating industry. What are the possibilities?

In order to make the most of internet marketing you need your own product. While you are working on it, you can make money selling other people's products. There is more than one way to do this. The first is affiliate marketing whereby you sell another person's product for a commission. Although you can sell hard goods and soft electronically delivered goods, the best commission deals are with the electronically deliverable goods such as software and ebooks. You can sell the same product time and time again, whereas with hard goods there are material and delivery costs involved with every item.

Typical commissions for hard goods are 5% - 10%, whereas those for electronic goods such as software or ebooks are around 50%. That's right. You typically earn 50% for every ebook you sell. That is why affiliate marketing is a technique of choice by many internet marketers who have no intention of producing their own product other than an ebook relating to others how they did it.

An important thing to keep in mind is that if you are selling products as an affiliate, you will need your own website. There are several possibilities for inexpensive web hosts available on the internet from about \$5 upwards per month. There are free hosting programs available, but it will cost you a lot for the ancillary software required to run a website, such as autoresponders, email systems and web design software that are provided with such systems as Hostgator and Third Sphere. Check the internet and choose a monthly system that you like. You can always change if you find you need something more comprehensive.

It is easy to find affiliate products to sell through a simple Google search. The principals provide you with all the sales aids you need, such as text links, banners and even sales pages, and also look after your customers. You simply send customers to the owner's sales site and wait for your commission.

Another home business idea is to purchase master resale rights to software and ebooks. Once you have the resale rights you can sell the products and keep 100% of the sales price. You can generally sell at the price you want, though there are some restrictions on minimum prices. If you want fewer restrictions, purchase private label rights. These allow you to put your name to the product and sell it as your own. You can also make alterations or even completely rewrite it so as to avoid duplication with others selling the same product.

If you have private label rights you can even put your affiliate links to any products offered for sale within it, and also insert your own AdSense blocks where relevant. There are several private label rights subscription sites on the internet that provide you with several products monthly for your monthly payment. These are excellent sources of products for those of you new to internet marketing, though it is important that you learn marketing techniques in order to effectively promote them.

There are other ways to make money without needing a website. For example you can buy and sell using eBay. Many people make a living purchasing items from eBay and reselling at a higher price. Others purchase wholesale and resell on eBay while yet others make a living using dropshipping. This is where you register with a dropshipper who provides you with a catalogue of products at wholesale prices. You sell for your own price on eBay and when you are paid, you send the wholesale price to the dropshipper along with the name and address of the purchaser, and the dropshipper looks after order fulfillment (i.e. delivery).

So, these are a few home business ideas for beginners at internet marketing. You should check them all out, do your research with a few internet searches, then take the plunge. Spend as much as you can afford on your website option, because that will be the whole base of your business eventually, and use the internet auction sites once you have learned how to do so to your advantage.

There is a whole world out there for you to reach and sell to, so be positive and you will succeed.

More On Online Home Based Business

An online home based business is ideal for anyone who has some spare time, such as a mother who has opted to look after her children rather than continue with her full time job, or anyone who is otherwise unemployed. There are many opportunities for such people to earn money online, even if not as the main household income.

The first, and major, advice I would give to anybody embarking on a home based business is not to overstretch yourself financially. Make a plan and set a budget for expenditure that you can afford. In spite of what you may read or hear, no internet business will be successful without some expenditure. You need money for a website, but if you find a business that does not need a website you will also need money for that. Ultimately, nothing comes free.

Even these MLM systems you might come across that state that no expenditure is necessary are talking rubbish. If no expenditure were ever necessary, there would never be any money going into the scheme. It is total nonsense. What that means is that no expenditure is necessary to the company, at least for the moment. You can spend as much as you like building your downline with online advertising, but you will not be able to use it until you eventually pay the entrance fee that is finally charged by all of these schemes that profess not to be MLM marketing systems, but companies with genuine products. In the end, the products are worthless and the downline pays you who in turn pays those above you.

Always check the internet to find out if they are scams or not. The best online home based business for you is to sell something that you own, or that is recognized as a genuine affiliate opportunity. Forget downlines and uplines. Sell product and you can't go wrong. That is where most individual online businesses make their money.

Affiliate marketing is a good place to start, but whatever you intend to do on the internet you will ultimately need your own website. So why not start with one? You can get free websites, though I would recommend you check the internet and get something that you pay a monthly sum for. You can get a good web host from under \$9 to around \$25 per month. Check out what they have to offer then make your choice.

You can find any number of affiliate programs on the internet. If you sell as an affiliate, you are selling somebody else's product for a commission. If you can find a good e-product such as software or an ebook to sell, you can get up to and above 50% commission on your sales, and since it is an electronic product, it can be delivered by an autoresponder, even while you are asleep.

There are other forms of home based businesses you could run, including selling resale rights or private label products, which give you 100% of the sales you make. These are easily advertised by means of articles and submissions to article directories, though you will again need a website.

There are some opportunities where you don't require your own website, but is provided to you by the company you are selling for. These opportunities are scattered round the internet, and you should be able to find one with a bit of searching. What is involved is that you advertise the product and lead your visitors to the website address provided to you which, although ostensibly your own, is one of many web pages of the owning company.

These opportunities can make you a lot of money, depending on how good you are at attracting leads. You might even purchase leads and hope that a proportion is interested in the product you are promoting. These schemes have their merits, but nothing can substitute for you having your own product to sell. Otherwise you are always selling somebody else's.

Which brings us to master resale rights or even private label rights products. In the former, you can sell the product, but not as your own. You keep all the sales you make, and the value to the originator is the affiliate links within it, the sales of which they get a commission. With private label rights, you get to put your own name as the author, and can change the title and content if you want. You can also change any affiliate links to your affiliate reference or nickname so that you get the commission on any sales made from people purchasing from the links within your book.

There are several ways in which to run your online home based business, and which you choose will be dependent on your own style of selling and the type of product you want to promote. The foregoing, however, might provide you with some ideas.
